DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Office & Warehouse Update - The voter's rolls are now closed and the State Board has given the local boards until October 18, 2014 to get all registrations entered into MDVoters system. The TV monitor in the lobby is now working and showing a power point presentation about voting information for Early Voting and Election Day.

The Fire Department inspected the warehouse and found there were some violations. Mr. Jones is working with the Fire Department on getting the warehouse up to code.

Warehouse Relocation - The Shannon Road location received another bid because no money had been allocated for the move. Mr. Jones contacted the Mayor's Office in City Hall and a letter of intent was signed and issued.

Election Judge Training - Training went well at Winston Elementary School. As of today 1,870 judges have been trained. The election judges liked this new location.
