**ELECTION DIRECTORS REPORT:**

Judges Department – The staff is working on checking in the interest letters that have been received back. Training of the election judges will start in March. We will let the Board know where and when so they can attend.

Moving- Senior staff has some doubts on the location that was suggested in Metro West. The area being offered is either the 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> floor. There is a lower level for the cabinets but not enough to set up the way we want, and we would still have use the freight elevators and there are multiple issues with them in case they would break

down. Another meeting is planned with the owners of the building and Mr. Keith Ross from the State Board of Elections that has been tasked by Ms. Lamone to help us with this. We had an initial meeting with him to go over our concerns such as entry and exit of the buildings, security etc.

Warehouse – Staff is starting to prepare the equipment to make sure its in working order and doing shredding of paperwork.
