Public notice of this canvass was provided on the Baltimore City Board of Elections website and through social media. Due to current social distancing guidelines and to comply with the Governor's Proclamation of May 6, 2020, public viewing will be by video conferencing only. The link to view the canvass is posted on the Baltimore City Board of Elections website.

#### VERIFICATION OF OPTICAL SCAN VOTING UNIT(S)

Mr. McAfee presented documents to the Board of Canvassers showing that the ballot scanner(s) being used in the canvass successfully passed Logic and Accuracy Testing. He also reported that the memory card(s) created for this canvass was/were placed in the ballot scanner(s) and sealed. Mr. McAfee provided the Board of Canvassers with the results from the Logic and Accuracy Testing. Mr. McAfee noted the Ballot Scanner Serial Number(s) and Seal Numbers from the Logic and Accuracy Testing documentation for each ballot scanner being used in the canvass.

Staff verified that the seal(s) on the ballot scanner(s) was/were intact and recorded the optical scan ballot scanner's serial number and seal number on the Scanning Unit Opening Integrity Report. #### **Overview of Canvass Process**

Mr. Jones will now provide an overview of the canvass process.

One important update is that, to the extent practicable, local board staff will be following the State Board of Elections procedure for curing vote by mail ballots returned without a signed oath. More specifically:

When an envelope is received without the oath being signed, an attempt will be made to contact the voter by email, telephone, or mail, depending on what information is available in the voter record.

To cure their ballot, voters may go to the local board office and sign the oath by appointment only. Voters should call the office when they arrive to facilitate signing the oath. Alternatively, the local board can email the voter the oath. The voter will then be required to print and sign the oath, and return it either in person, by mail, or by email if the person scans or takes a picture of the oath.

All oaths must be signed and received by the local board not later than 10:00 a.m. on the 2nd Friday after Election Day or they will be rejected. Ballots that are returned without a signed oath will be canvassed on the final day of canvassing to allow time for the signed oath to be received.

#### **Challenge a Ballot During Canvass**

Mr. Jones explained how to Challenge a Ballot During Canvass. The Board will reconvene for the review of ballots every Tuesday and Thursday at 3:00 pm. The public may challenge a ballot during this time. They will need to announce the challenge using the Q&A option in the Microsoft Teams live-stream. They will need to complete the Challenge During Canvass Form This is a fillable form. They will need to ensure the form is signed. If it is not signed the challenge will not be accepted. They will need to email it as a PDF attachment to election.judge@baltimorecity.gov. Once the Challenge During Canvass Form is received, the Board will take action on that ballot.

#### **Canvass Participants**


