DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Early Voting Update ~ All six early voting locations are ready for voting. The sites that have been moved will have a banner hung informing the voter where the new voting site is located.

Warehouse Update ~ The warehouse staff is currently packing the cabinets that will be delivered to each polling place with the supplies that are needed for Election Day.

Election Judge Training ~ 2,300 election judges have been trained. This includes an extra judge for each polling place.

Sample Ballots ~ Sample ballots were mailed to each voter.

Office Update ~ The staff has been working overtime to process all voter authority cards by 9:00 p.m. this evening, April 8, 2016.

Voter Outreach Demonstrations ~ Over 100 demonstrations of the new voting machines have been completed. The demonstrations will continue in the summer.

ATTORNEY'S REPORT

The automatic voter registration bill did not pass.

NEW BUSINESS

The board voted to have Ms. Deitra Redmond to serve as President of the canvass and Ms. Sidney Shelton to serve as Secretary.

Ms. Deitra Redmond made a motion to adjourn the Board meeting; Ms. Sidney Shelton seconded the motion. Motion carried.
